

PRIVACY POLICY

Females who want to take the prescription medication ambrisentan are required to register and participate in the Ambrisentan REMS Program. Under the Ambrisentan REMS Program, only prescribers, pharmacies, and distributors registered in the Ambrisentan REMS Program are able to prescribe, dispense and distribute (as applicable), ambrisentan containing products. In order to fulfill the requirements of the Ambrisentan REMS Program, the Ambrisentan ANDA REMS Group, or its agents, affiliates, and authorized representatives, who are the owner of this Ambrisentan REMS Program 'website' (together, referred to as "AARG") must obtain personal information from you. Protecting your privacy is very important to AARG. Please read the following to learn more about AARG privacy policy ("Privacy Policy").

What This Privacy Policy Covers

- This Privacy Policy covers how AARG treats personal information that AARG collects and receives. Personal information is information about you that is personally identifiable like your name, address, email address, or phone number, and that is not otherwise publicly available.
- This Privacy Policy does not apply to the practices of companies that AARG does not own or control, or to people that AARG does not employ or manage.

Information Collection and General Use

- AARG collects personal information when you register with the Ambrisentan REMS Program, when you use ambrisentan products or services, and when you visit www.AmbrisentanREMS.com.
- When you register as a prescriber, pharmacist or distributor, AARG asks for information which may include (but may not be limited to) your name, contact information and professional identifier numbers (e.g. DEA, NPI and/or NCPDP numbers). When you register as a patient, your prescriber or prescriber's designated agent collects information about you which may include (but may not be limited to) your name, email address, birth date, gender, zip code, and address to register you in the Ambrisentan REMS Program. Once you are registered with the Ambrisentan REMS Program and sign in to Ambrisentan REMS Program services, you are not anonymous to AARG.
- As a patient, AARG collects health-related information from you, your prescriber and/or prescriber's designated agent to fulfill requirements to comply with the Ambrisentan REMS Program.
- AARG collects information about your transactions within the Ambrisentan REMS Program.
- AARG automatically receives and records information on AARG's back-end server logs from your computer, including your IP address - but AARG does not associate the IP address with a username or any specific web pages visited. AARG stores IP addresses on the server indefinitely.
 - An IP (Internet Provider) address is a number assigned to your computer for access to the Internet. All computer identification on the Internet is conducted with IP addresses, which allow computers and servers to recognize and communicate with each other.
- AARG uses your identifiable personal information to fulfill your requests for Ambrisentan REMS Program products and services, to verify your registration in the Ambrisentan REMS Program, to conduct research about the Ambrisentan REMS Program, to assess compliance with the Ambrisentan REMS Program, to contact you on Ambrisentan REMS Program-related matters, and, to the extent applicable, to provide consumers with information regarding pharmacies registered with the Ambrisentan REMS Program. Before information is reported to the companies that sponsor the Ambrisentan REMS Program (i.e., the manufacturers of ambrisentan containing products) or the FDA, your personal identifying information is removed. AARG uses aggregated (non-personally identifiable) information to help AARG understand trends, website performance and patient needs. For example, AARG may analyze the gender or age of visitors to the www.AmbrisentanREMS.com site, and AARG may use that analysis of aggregate data internally or share it with others such as

companies that sponsor the Ambrisentan REMS Program (i.e., the manufacturers of ambrisentan containing products) and the FDA.

Information Sharing and Disclosure

- AARG does not rent or sell personal information about you to other people or nonaffiliated companies for any reason. Furthermore, AARG does not share personal information about you with other people or affiliated or nonaffiliated companies except to provide products or services you've requested, when AARG has your permission, or under the following circumstances:
 - AARG provides information to companies who work on behalf of or with AARG under confidentiality agreements. These companies may use your personal information to help AARG communicate with you about matters regarding your health only as it relates to the Ambrisentan REMS Program. These companies do not have any independent right to share or use this information.
 - AARG responds to subpoenas, court orders, or legal process, or to establish or exercise AARG's legal rights or defend against legal claims.
 - AARG believes it is necessary to share information in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, violations of Ambrisentan REMS Program's Terms of Use, or as otherwise required by law.

Internet Tracking

- AARG uses a tracking technology to track how many times each page is visited and how many times a particular document is downloaded. This information is used to analyze trends and perform diagnostic services such as error reporting to improve the Ambrisentan REMS Program website. AARG receives reports based on the use of tracking technologies on an individual as well as aggregated basis.
- The tracking technology does not associate page visits to a specific IP address.

Confidentiality and Security

- AARG limits access to personal information about you to employees, contractors, and agents who AARG believes reasonably need to come into contact with that information to provide Ambrisentan REMS Program products or services to you or in order to successfully complete tasks as part of their employment. Personal information is never used for marketing or sales purposes.
- AARG has physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with federal regulations to protect personal information about you.

Children's Privacy

- The Ambrisentan REMS Program website is not intended for any user under the age of 13, and AARG does not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age of 13. AARG requests that children under the age of 13 not submit any personal information through the Ambrisentan REMS Program website.

How AARG Responds to "Do Not Track" Signals

- Some web browsers have a "Do Not Track" feature. This feature allows you to tell websites you visit that you do not want to have your online activity tracked over time and across websites. These features are not yet uniform across browsers. The Ambrisentan REMS Program website is not currently set up to respond to those signals.

Visiting Ambrisentan REMS Program Website From Outside the United States

- The use and content of the Ambrisentan REMS Program website is intended for U.S. residents only. This Privacy Policy is intended to apply to collection of information from residents of the United States. If you are not a resident of the United States, please be aware that your information may be transferred to, stored, and processed in the United States.

Changes to this Privacy Policy

- AARG may, from time to time and at its discretion, update this Privacy Policy. AARG will notify you about significant changes in the way AARG treats personal information either by sending a communication to the primary email address specified in your Ambrisentan REMS Program account or by placing a prominent notice on the Ambrisentan REMS Program website.
